TRAINING AIDS

ELTC/ASN is equipped with the following modern training aids.

White Boards, Personal Computer, Printer, Display Board, Scanner, Public Address System, Smart Class etc.

WAG-9/WAP-5/WAP-7 Loco Simulator

One WAG-9/WAP-5 Simulator installed at Electric Loco Training Centre, Eastern Railway, Asansol. The simulator training for WAG-9/WAP-5 Loco Pilots is very much essential for achieving economy, reliability, safety and punctuality in train operation. The Simulator training is being imparting in two shifts. 10 candidates in each shift i.e, 20 candidates per course may be trained.

MODEL ROOM

The following working models are designed and fabricated at ELTC for the benefit of the various trainees coming for the initial, promotional and refresher courses.

1. Working model of WAG – 7 Loco.
2. Working model of EMU/MEMU
3. Working model of Air braked bogie.
4. Working model of Pantograph.
5. Loco apparatus.
6. Glow shine circuit diagram of Control circuits.
7. Glow shine circuit diagram of Pneumatic circuits.
8. Glow shine circuit diagram of Auxiliary circuits.
9. Glow shine circuit diagram of Power circuits.

LIBRARY

A Library which comprises of ACTM, Maintenance manual for WAG-5, Maintenance manual for WAG-7 and WAP -4, Trouble shooting directory for WAG-9 and WAP-5, Loco Pilot's manual of WAG-9, Trouble shooting directory of Micro processor fitted loco, Maintenance manual for WAP-1, Maintenance manual of MEMU, Establishment Rule book, GR books in Hindi, English and Bengali, Operation of Electric Locomotive covering a wide range of trouble shooting of different types of electric locomotives and general rule for the safe operation of train is available for the benefit of trainees. Apart from this different technical books, Establishment Rule, Track Engineering etc. are also available in this library.

HOSTEL ACCOMMODATION

There are two hostels available for the trainees with a capacity of 280 beds. One room attached with bathrooms of 12 beds is kept especially for ladies trainees.

MESS

The mess is managed by the trainees themselves on no profit no loss basis. The infrastructure is also provided by Railway. The facility of cooking gas is available. 100 nos. of trainees can take meal at a time in the dining room. There is arrangement of Veg non-veg meal for trainees also.

MEDICAL ASSISTANCE

Divisional Railway Hospital is situated within 700 meters from Training Centre & Hostel.

RECREATION

Hostel is provided with a TV room and a reading room. Newspapers, Weekly Magazines in Hindi, English and Bengali are also available. Sporting facilities, Outdoor games like volley ball and Indoor games like Table Tennis, Caroms, Chess, Cards etc. are available.

YOGA CENTRE

In addition to the academic activities, yoga and meditation classes are regularly conducted to improve the attitude of the trainees under the able guidance of Yoga instructor.

GYM:

One GYM Hall is situated in Hostel. It is equipped with Exercise cycle, Stress relieving foot massager, Portable Jogging Walking Machine etc.

METHODOLOGY OF TRAINING

In the introductory session the background of the trainees is taken and based on the lowest qualification in the group, the training programme is modified appropriately by the Instructor. The course material is given to the trainees before they attend the classes so that trainees can go through the same before the session start. Instructor before starting his subject in the class room session always tell in brief what the session is about the main course and confirm to the trainees what has been covered. Lecturing is always given with the help of teaching aids i.e. Glow Shine Circuit diagram, LCD Technology Resolution etc., Coaching, Demonstration, Practical training in model car , visit in shed , simulator & Case studies.

SYSTEM OF EVALUATION OF THE TRAINEES

Class Test, Written Test, Viva Voce Test, Computer software having enormous questions & answers in form of objective types. Simulation of faults on working model and trouble shooting by Loco Pilots.

EXAMINATION

1. Examination is held after the completion of each course as per schedule.
2. This is to be noted by all concern that as per laid down rules answers can be written in English or Hindi only.
3. Extracts from the “*Manual on Management*” issued by Railway Board is appended below regarding rules applicable for train passing/train running staff failing twice in the prescribed Refresher please.

5.5.2.2 : - Staff employed in Train passing/Train running duties, like Station Masters, Asstt. Station Masters, Switchmen, Cabin Men, Guards and Drivers must pass an appropriate examination at the end of periodical Refresher Course. In case they fail to pass the prescribed examination, special arrangement will be made by the Railway Administration to repeat the Refresher Course immediately or after a short period, the staff being granted leave as due to cover the intervening period or temporarily deployed in other jobs. However, if they fail in the second attempt also, they would be absorbed in an alternate category. An employee so absorbed in an alternate category is allowed to undertake further refresher course at intervals of not less than six months, but such a course is to be taken by the employee availing his/her own leave. On passing the refresher course examination such staff are absorbed in the original category on the occurrence of the first vacancy.

5.5.2.3 : - “A Driver, who fails twice in the prescribed examination after refresher course, is to be deployed as a Shunter without giving any refresher course prescribed for the Shunter.

As per RBE No. 113/2004, Training Manual Correction Slip No. 3/2004, Pass marks for trainees undergoing Initial, Promotional, Refresher or Specialised courses in training centres are as follows:

- (a) Pass marks in the examination conducted by the training centres at the end of the course for safety categories including running staff should be 60% i.e., staff must secure 60% in written and 60% in practical/viva to qualify the exam. with no relaxation for SC/ST. Where the examination consists of only written or viva or practical, staff must secure 60% marks in the same to qualify. It is immaterial whether safety category staff appears in a safety or non-safety subject.
- (b) The question papers In the initial and promotional courses should contain only 40% of the total marks as objective type questions and balance 60% of the total marks as subjective type questions. Question paper in refresher courses should have 70% of the total marks as objective type and the balance 30% of the total marks as subjective type questions.
- (c) Computer Base Test (CBT) has been introduced with with introduction of 100% of objective type multiple choice paper for the refresher course examination both Loco Pilot and Assistant Loco Pilot (Periodicity, once in 3 years) at ETC/ASN on the similar lines of induction and Promotional examinations approved by Railwaay Board.

FUTURE IMPROVEMENTS

One Simulator (for EMU/MEMU) sanctioned in M & P Programme is under process. Construction of 2nos. Of class rooms and 4nos. Of hostel rooms have been started in 1st phase under umbrella work.

Proposal for construction of another 6nos. Of class rooms and 7nos. Of hostel rooms are under process.

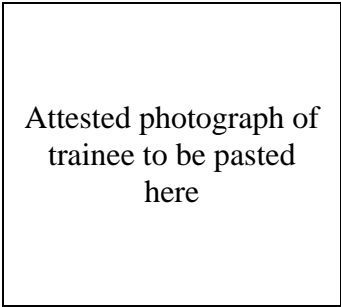
General Information and Instructions

1. Normal working hour in the training centre is from 09.15 hrs. to 17.00 hrs. with lunch break from 13.00 hrs. to 14.30 hrs.
2. Divisions are required to book the staff for the courses according to quota (10 for each course from each division except simulator and Vande Bharat batches) basis for the divisions to avoid wastage of training capacities created at this centre
3. Divisions are required to make necessary arrangement as per system in vogue for payment of the pay and allowance of the staff booked to undergo training at ETC/Asansol to the persons by way of pay authorities or otherwise. No refresher, promotional or other trainees are spared either on leave or as ORS to draw their pays and allowances from their Headquarters.
4. In the spared letter of staff booked for training (**Refresher/Promotional**) particulars of Designation, HQ, Division, Rate of Pay, Date of birth, Father's Name, whether SC/ST, Particulars of Passes/PTO's and CL/LAP of individual trainees should be mentioned clearly as per proforma enclosed herewith. This should be in duplicate, one for ETC/ASN and another for ZRTI/Bhuli.

5. Trainees booked to attend any course at ETC/ASN should be advised to report to Hostel Warden, ETC Hostel between 09.00 hrs. to 17.00 hrs. one day in advance, so that they may not face any inconvenience for their hostel accommodation.
6. The training centre will provide Pillow, Blanket, Bed-sheet & Mosquito net, one each, to each trainee for their use during their stay.
7. All trainees attending the training courses should wear their respective prescribed uniform with close shoes while attending the classes.
8. Privilege passes and PTOs will not be issued from this end to trainees except in case of emergency.
9. Return journey ORS pass must be given to the trainees. In case of Refresher and Promotional trainees ORS pass must be given up to Bhuli, if required. No ORS return journey pass or ORS pass for transportation training course at MDZTI/Bhuli will be issued to the trainees from this centre.
10. Maintenance of discipline of the training centre is a major factor and breach of discipline may lead to discontinuation of the training course.
11. Consuming of alcohol during class hours and hostel premises is strictly prohibited.
12. Trainees are not allowed to stay away from Hostel beyond 22.00 hrs.
13. No leave will be granted to the trainees during the period of training, except in emergency cases.
14. 90 % attendance is must for appearing in the examination.
15. Yoga training is compulsory to all trainees in the morning session from 06.30 to 08.00 at hostel. All trainees attending the Yoga Class should wear their respective prescribed uniform- White T-Shirt & White trouser for Male and White salavar kameez for Female.
16. Trainees are encouraged to take part in extra curricular activities like sports & games, cultural functions as and when organised by ETC/Asansol.
17. A garden lawn is maintained at ETC, Asansol with the help of trainees and trainees are expected to offer their voluntary services (SHRAMDAAN) for the same to develop a good culture and create a pleasant environment.
18. Government' instructions issued time to time to be followed for Corona protocol.
